Thank you never seems enough for your gifts that provided for an incredible year of ministry in the 2021-2022 school year! The Jason Paul Cameron Foundation was able to provide over \$30,000 to ministries that touch many lives thanks to your continued support last year!

We are grateful for the opportunity each year to provide the Daily Evaluation locker cards to area students at "See You at the Pole." These cards are a visual reminder to students from elementary, middle and high schools to focus on Christ in their daily lives. We love receiving pictures of the card in students' notebooks, on their mirror or another place where they will see it each day. We continue to place Bibles and devotionals in the hands of hundreds of teenagers and provide scholarship funds to area churches for students to attend summer youth camps. We pray these teenagers learn about Christ's love for them, grow in their faith, and demonstrate the love of Christ to others.

New this year, we partnered with the Fenn Leadership Center at First West to provide scholarship funds to seminary students serving as ministry residents within the church. Matching grants from the seminaries doubled the impact of these scholarships, providing an exciting new way to further God's kingdom work as these students prepare for ministry. Also, we honored our 2022 high school graduates with \$12,000 in academic scholarships this year!

Our provision of the book *Good Grief* continues to support families and individuals in grief. We learned of a young lady who found the book helpful and shared it with others. The Foundation provided additional copies to her, and she ministered to many college students as they journeyed through grief. The Foundation provides these books at no cost to area grief ministries or churches that request copies, as well as to family members when the Foundation receives a memorial for their loved one.

Each November we publish our newsletter in memory of Jason on his birthday. We are grateful to each of you for your continued partnership that allows us to share Christ's love with others through our ministry. May God bless you in the coming year!

3. How would other people describe my attitude today?
4. Did I spend time with Jesus today?
